

# HEALTHY CAMP GUIDELINES

**MIRACLE BIBLE CAMP** has adopted the following guidelines in cooperation with Minn. Department of Health requirements\*

- Cloth face masks are **required** in any building with public space including the Dining Hall (masks are not required in your assigned cabin).
- Table seating will be by cabin group (cohort)
- Tables are spaced to provide the distance recommended in MDH guidelines.
- Publicly shared items will be cleaned and sanitized after use prior to being reused.
- Each morning at camp a temperature check will be done for each camper and staff.



**Before arrival at camp**, please conduct the following Visitor and Employee Health Screening Checklist:

Have you had any of the following symptoms since your last day at work or the last time you were here that you cannot attribute to another health condition?

- Fever (100.4°F or higher), or feeling feverish?
- Chills?
- A new cough?
- Shortness of breath?
- A new sore throat?
- New muscle aches?
- New headache?
- New loss of smell or taste?

**If these conditions** are noticed, please contact camp.

**If these conditions develop while at camp**, please notify your counselor and the camp office at once; avoid unnecessary contact with others while doing so.
