

HEALTHY CAMP GUIDELINES

MIRACLE BIBLE CAMP has adopted the following guidelines in cooperation with Minn. Department of Health requirements*

- Cloth face masks are **required** in any building with public space including the Dining Hall (masks are not required in your assigned cabin).
- Limit table seating to 4 persons (6 if from the same household).
- Tables are spaced 6 feet apart to provide the required distance in compliance with MDH guidelines.
- Publicly shared items (e.g. kayaks, paddles, life jackets) and surfaces (e.g. tables) must be cleaned and sanitized after use prior to being reused. Avoid using items that cannot be sanitized readily.



Before arrival at camp, and each morning at camp please conduct the following Visitor and Employee Health Screening Checklist:

Have you had any of the following symptoms since your last day at work or the last time you were here that you cannot attribute to another health condition?

- Fever (100.4°F or higher), or feeling feverish?
- Chills?
- A new cough?
- Shortness of breath?
- A new sore throat?
- New muscle aches?
- New headache?
- New loss of smell or taste?

If these conditions are noticed, please contact camp.

If these conditions develop while at camp, please notify your counselor and the camp office at once; avoid unnecessary contact with others while doing so.
